

# Documentation Addendum for Silent Installation Mode

This documentation addendum for silent mode installation for the SDX software applies to the *Installing the SDX-300 Software* chapter in the following documents:

- 5.1.x *SDX-300 Software Basics Guide*
- 5.0.x *SDX-300 Software Basics Guide*
- 4.2.x *SDX-300 Installation and Configuration Guide* (used in Releases 4.2.x and 4.3.x)
- 4.1.x *SDX-300 Installation and Configuration Guide*

The *Silent Mode* section of the *Installing the SDX-300 Software* chapter lists 4 of the 6 command arguments for the **UMCsdx.bin** command. It does not list the following arguments:

- ADMIN\_FILE
- INSTALLER\_DATA\_DIR

These two arguments are needed for complete installation of the SDX software.

The description of the **UMCsdx.bin** command should read as follows:

To start the installation process in silent mode, enter the following command at the UNIX command line:

```
./UMCsdx.bin -D[argument]="[value]" -i silent
```

The following table shows the possible inputs to this command.

[argument]	default [value]	Notes
ADMIN_FILE	pkgadd.SSC.default	SDX Admin file
INSTALLER_DATA_DIR	/opt/UMC/var/InstallerData	Installation data directory
USER_INSTALL_DIR	/opt/UMC	Installation destination directory
USER_INPUT_RESULT_1	sdxuser	User
USER_INPUT-RESULT_2	staff	Group
MEDIAFOLDER	cdrom/cdrom0/SDX	Installation source directory
