}

Release Information Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.4 for EX-series switches.

Description Specify a local pathname or remote URL for the DHCP snooping database file to maintain persistence of IP-MAC bindings.

The remaining statements are explained separately.

Default The IP-MAC bindings in the DHCP snooping database file are not persistent. If the switch is rebooted, the bindings are lost.

Required Privilege Level routing—To view this statement in the configuration.
routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
