<b>Syntax</b>	ca-value <i>value</i> ;
<b>Hierarchy Level</b>	[edit protocols lldp-med interface (all   <i>interface-name</i> ) location civic-based ca-type <i>number</i> ]
<b>Release Information</b>	Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.0 for EX-series switches.
<b>Description</b>	For Link Layer Discovery Protocol Media Endpoint Device (LLDP-MED), configure location information, such as street address and city, that is indexed by the ca-type code. This information is advertised from the switch to the MED and is used during emergency calls to identify the location of the MED.
<b>Default</b>	Disabled.
<b>Options</b>	<i>value</i> —Specify a value that correlates to the <b>ca-type</b> . See ca-type for a list of codes and suggested values.
<b>Required Privilege Level</b>	routing—To view this statement in the configuration. routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
