<b>Syntax</b>	demux-source { source-address; }
<b>Hierarchy Level</b>	[edit dynamic-profiles <i>profile-name</i> interfaces demux0 unit <i>logical-unit-number</i> family <i>family</i> ]
<b>Release Information</b>	Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.0. The [edit dynamic-profiles <i>profile-name</i> ] hierarchy added in JUNOS Release 9.3.
<b>Description</b>	Configure a logical demultiplexing (demux) source address for a subscriber in a dynamic profile.
<b>Options</b>	<b>source-address</b> —Either the specific source address you want to assign to the subscriber interface or the source address variable (\$junos-subscriber-ip-address). The source address for the interface is dynamically supplied by DHCP when the subscriber accesses the router.  The remaining statements are explained separately.
<b>Required Privilege Level</b>	interface—To view this statement in the configuration. interface-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
