**Release Information**    Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.0 for EX-series switches.

**Description**    Configure the Multiple Spanning Tree Instance (MSTI) identifier for Multiple Spanning Tree Protocol (MSTP). MSTI IDs are local to each region, so you can reuse the same MSTI ID in different regions.

**Default**    MSTI is disabled.

**Options**    *msti-id* —MSTI identifier.

**Range:** 1 through 4094. The Common Instance Spanning Tree (CIST) is always MSTI 0.
