<b>Description</b>	Configure the order of authentication, authorization, and accounting (AAA) servers to use while sending accounting messages and updates.
<b>Default</b>	Not enabled
<b>Options</b>	<p>none—No accounting for specified subscribers.</p> <p>radius—Remote Authentication Dial-In User Service accounting for specified subscribers.</p> <p>[ radius   none ]— Use multiple types of accounting in the order specified. RADIUS accounting is initially used. However, if RADIUS servers are not available, no accounting is done.</p>
<b>Required Privilege Level</b>	<p>admin—To view this statement in the configuration.</p> <p>admin-control—To add this statement to the configuration.</p>
