Hierarchy Level [edit dynamic-profiles routing-options access-internal route *subscriber-ip-address*]

Release Information Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.5.

Description Dynamically configure the qualified next-hop and the MAC address for an access-internal route.

Options *underlying-interface*—Either the specific logical underlying interface you want to assign to the access route or the underlying interface variable (\$junos-underlying-interface). The underlying interface variable is dynamically replaced with the value supplied by DHCP when a subscriber logs in.

The remaining statement is explained separately.

Required Privilege Level routing—To view this statement in the configuration.
 routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
