<b>Release Information</b>	Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.5 for EX-series switches.
<b>Description</b>	Enable Resource Reservation Protocol (RSVP) signaling. The primary purpose of RSVP in JUNOS software for EX-series switches is to support dynamic signaling within label switched paths (LSPs).
<b>Default</b>	RSVP is disabled.
<b>Required Privilege Level</b>	routing—To view this statement in the configuration. routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
