Description	For MAC addresses that are on the static MAC list and excluded from 802.1X authentication, configure the VLAN that is associated with the device.
Options	<i>vlan-id</i> <i>vlan-name</i> —The name of the VLAN or the VLAN tag identifier to associate with the device. The VLAN already exists on the switch.
