<b>Hierarchy Level</b>	[edit protocols lldp-med interface (all   <i>interface-name</i> location)]
<b>Release Information</b>	Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.0 for EX Series switches.
<b>Description</b>	For Link Layer Discovery Protocol–Media Endpoint Discovery (LLDP-MED), configure the Emergency Line Identification Number (ELIN) as location information. Location information is advertised from the switch to the MED device and is used during emergency calls to identify the location of the MED device.
<b>Default</b>	Disabled.
<b>Options</b>	<i>number</i> —Configure a 10-digit number (area code and telephone number).
<b>Required Privilege Level</b>	routing—To view this statement in the configuration. routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
