Release Information Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.5.

Description Dynamically configure parameters for an access-internal route.

Options *subscriber-ip-address*—Either the specific IP address you want to assign to the access-internal route or the subscriber IP address variable (\$junos-subscriber-ip-address). The subscriber IP address variable is dynamically replaced with the value supplied by DHCP when a subscriber logs in.

The remaining statements are explained separately.

Required Privilege Level routing—To view this statement in the configuration.
 routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
