

## tunnel-subscriber authentication

---

<b>Syntax</b>	tunnel-subscriber authentication { enable   disable }  no tunnel-subscriber authentication
<b>Release Information</b>	Command introduced in JUNOS Release 9.1.0.
<b>Description</b>	Configures whether tunnel subscribers within the domain map are authenticated with the authentication server or are granted access without individual authentication. The <b>no</b> version restores the default condition, where users are not authenticated by an authentication server.
<b>Options</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ enable—Enables tunnel subscriber authentication by the authentication server</li><li>■ disable—Disables tunnel subscriber authentication by the authentication server; all users in the domain are granted access without individual authentication; this is the default condition</li></ul>
<b>Mode</b>	Domain Map Configuration
