

## Configuring QoS Profile Attachment Actions (C-Web Interface)

---

Use this action to specify the name of the QoS profile to attach to the router interface when this action is taken. You can configure QoS actions for JUNOS policy rules.

The router allows only one QoS profile to be attached to an interface at one time. Therefore, as a subscriber activates and deactivates different services, the QoS profile running on the interface needs to change. The SRC software provides a QoS-tracking plug-in (QTP) that you can use to ensure that as a subscriber activates and deactivates services, the required QoS profile is attached to the subscriber interface. To configure a QoS profile attachment action:

1. In the side pane, select a JUNOS policy rule.
2. From the Create new list, select **Qos Attach**. Type a name for the QoS profile attachment action, and click **OK**.
3. Enter information as described in the Help text in the main pane, and click **Apply**.
