

## Decoding Trap Numbers for Clear Trap Actions

---

To decode a trap number for clear trap actions:

- Use the following equation:

$$\text{Trap number} = \text{Trap ID} * 10$$

For example, if the trap number is 250, then the trap ID is 25 (saeAccPendingRequests). Therefore, a trap number of 250 means that the saeAccPendingRequests alarm has been cleared.
