

Connecting to a Remote Host Through SSH

To connect to a remote host through SSH:

- In operational mode, enter the following command.

```
user@host> ssh host host <v1 | v2>
```

where:

- *host* —Hostname or IP address of the remote host. You can specify a username by using the format *user@host* for *host* . If you do not specify a username, the command uses the username of the current user.
- <v1 | v2>—Version of SSH, 1 or 2.
