

## Configuring Policy Groups (SRC CLI)

---

Policy groups hold policy lists. You can create policy groups within policy folders. Use the following configuration statement to create a policy group:

```
policies group name {  
    description description ;  
}
```

To create a policy group:

1. From configuration mode, enter the **edit policies group** statement. For example, to create a folder called dhcp-default:

```
user@host# edit policies group dhcp-default
```

2. (Optional) Enter a description for the policy group.

```
[edit policies group dhcp-default]  
user@host# set description description
```

3. (Optional) Verify your policy group configuration.

```
[edit policies group dhcp-default]  
user@host#show  
description "Default policy for JUNOSe routers";
```
