Syntax [no] service check-config [auto | fileName *fileName* | running-configuration | running-configuration recover | auto-recover]

Release Information Command introduced in JUNOS Release 9.3.0.
auto-recover keyword added in JUNOS Release 10.3.0.

Description Detects corruption of running configuration and CNF files on both the primary and the standby SRP when it is due to a fatal duplicate key error. The **no** version restores the default action, manual detection.

- Options**
- **auto**—Checks the running configuration at regular intervals; cannot be used for CNF files
 - **fileName**—Name of an existing configuration file (.cnf) that needs to be validated for corruption
 - **running-configuration**—Specifies that the running configuration needs to be validated for corruption
 - **running-configuration recover**—Recovers the corrupted configuration files in the running configuration
 - **auto-recover**—Specifies that the running configuration needs to be validated for corruption and the corrupted files need to be recovered
