

CLI on the SRX 210 Services Gateway

The JUNOS software command-line interface (CLI) is the primary tool for controlling and troubleshooting services gateway hardware, the JUNOS software, routing protocols, and network connectivity. CLI commands display information from routing tables, information specific to routing protocols, and information about network connectivity derived from the ping and trace route utilities.

You need to enter CLI commands on one or more external management devices connected to the services gateway to display the information.
