This letter is to address the possibility of any user data residing on a Juniper M7i chassis after the unit has been powered down. The parts that make up the chassis are the metal shell and the Midplane. The chassis is the physical housing of the various parts that make up an M7i Router. The Midplane is a passive device that provides the physical interconnection of the devices that make up the router such as the Power Supplies and Routing Engine.

The chassis and Midplane are passive components, so these components do not store any user information at all. Juniper Networks certifies that no user data/information is stored in the chassis or Midplane during normal operation or when powered off.
