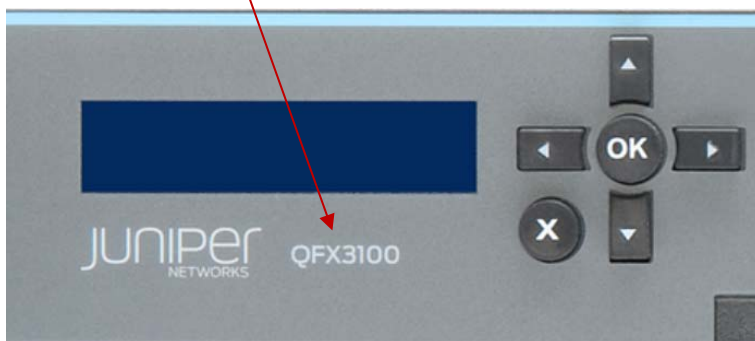

1 IDENTIFICATION OF CHASSIS



The QFX3100 QFabric Director can be identified by the model number on the front panel overlay under the LCD window.

Additionally, on the rear of the unit is a serial number sticker with a 16 digit serial number that starts with "0281."



2 POWER DOWN AND REMOVAL OF NON-VOLATILE STORAGE

In order to ensure that no user data or system configurations remain resident on a QFX3100 platform, the following steps must be performed:

1. Power must be removed from the system to clear all volatile storage
2. The two hard drives must be removed from the system
 - a. Unscrew the two thumbscrews on each hard drive module
 - b. Pull on the thumbscrews to completely remove the hard drive module from the system



USB Restore media

The QFX3100 ships with USB install/restore media. As shipped from Juniper, it contains only a factory install image. However, this writable media should be considered non-volatile storage and **may** be used to store other types of data beyond the QFX3100 factory image it was shipped with.
