Junos Pulse 3.2R1

Android Known Issues and Limitations

- On the Samsung Galaxy S II (model GT-I9100), the soft keypad might disappear when the user tries to enter the VPN login password. (705519)
- Downloading a file via Windows share bookmark or intranet web email client does not work. (704414, 686483, 678795, 658663)
- User can login to a non-existing URL if the URL contains a correct URL substring. For example, if a correct URL is "https://<sa host>/mobile", user can login to an URL that is https://<sa host>/mobileabc. (687952)

VPN

- If the network becomes unavailable during a VPN session, DNS settings are not restored to pre-VPN state when the VPN session is reconnecting. This is expected behaviour. When the network becomes available, or when the VPN session is reestablished, DNS settings are restored. (686823)
- Junos Pulse on Android: Certificate Authentication on Android 3.0 and 3.1 may report a missing certificate error. (699220)
- VPN is not supported when proxy is configured either on client or server ([688360](#))
- If a user is mapped to multiple roles, role_1 is configured with Host Checker policy with MSS check, role_2 is configured without any Host Checker policy, although a remediation rule is configured, user still fails to login to SA without failing over to role_2. (740191)

MSS

- A certificate error is reported by the Pulse client when it tries to connect to an MSG server that is behind a Zeus load balancer. (690124)
- If upgrading from Pulse mobile 2.0 Android client, you have to get a virus definition upgrade for the Pulse client to detect viruses correctly. This issue only happens when upgrading from Pulse mobile 2.0 client. (672752)
- On a device that has fast reboot enabled, unlock command is not working after shutdown and power on the device. (746962)
