**Syntax** committed-information-rate *bits-per-second*;

**Hierarchy Level** [edit firewall three-color-policer *policer-name* single-rate]  
[edit firewall three-color-policer *policer-name* two-rate]

**Release Information** Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 7.4.

**Description** Configure the guaranteed bandwidth under normal line conditions, and the average rate up to which packets are marked with low packet-loss priority (green).



**NOTE:** When you configure `committed-information-rate` you must also configure `committed-burst-size`.

---

**Options** *bits-per-second*—Number of bits per second. You can specify a value in bits per second either as a complete decimal number or as a decimal number followed by the abbreviation k (1000), m (1,000,000), or g (1,000,000,000).

**Range:** 32,000 through 40,000,000,000 bps

**Required Privilege Level** firewall—To view this statement in the configuration.  
firewall-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
