**Syntax** dhcp-snooping-file {  
    location *local\_pathname* | *remote\_URL*;  
    timeout *seconds*;  
    write-interval *seconds*;  
}

**Hierarchy Level** [edit ethernet-switching-options secure-access-port]

**Release Information** Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.4 for EX-series switches.

**Description** Specify a local pathname or remote URL for the DHCP snooping database file to maintain persistence of IP-MAC bindings.

The remaining statements are explained separately.

**Default** The IP-MAC bindings in the DHCP snooping database file are not persistent. If the switch is rebooted, the bindings are lost.

**Required Privilege Level** routing—To view this statement in the configuration.  
routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
