**Syntax** install {  
    *destination-prefix* <active>;  
}

**Hierarchy Level** [edit logical-systems *logical-system-name* protocols mpls label-switched-path *lsp-name*],  
[edit logical-systems *logical-system-name* protocols mpls static-label-switched-path  
    *lsp-name* ingress],  
[edit protocols mpls label-switched-path *lsp-name*],  
[edit protocols mpls static-label-switched-path *lsp-name* ingress]

**Release Information** Statement introduced before JUNOS Release 7.4.

**Description** Associate one or more prefixes with an LSP. When the LSP is up, all the prefixes are installed as entries into the **inet.3** routing table.

**Options** **active**—(Optional) Install the route into the **inet.0** routing table. This allows you to issue a **ping** or **traceroute** command on this address.

*destination-prefix*—Address to associate with the LSP.

**Required Privilege Level** routing—To view this statement in the configuration.  
routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
