Release Information Statement introduced in JUNOS Release 9.0 for EX Series switches.

Description Configure Link Layer Discovery Protocol (LLDP). The switch uses LLDP to advertise its identity and capabilities on a LAN, as well as receive information about other network devices. LLDP is defined in the IEEE standard 802.1AB-2005.

The statements are explained separately.

Default LLDP is enabled.

Required Privilege Level routing—To view this statement in the configuration.
routing-control—To add this statement to the configuration.
